Health Information

All horses on the grounds must provide to the show office:

- A copy of their negative coggins, dated between 10/22/17 & 10/21/18
- Proof of vaccination per USEF GR 845, dated between 4/22/18 and 10/21/18

PA Department of Agriculture requires that all horses on the grounds be able to provide proof of the following, as applicable to each horse.

A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required for all equine imported into this Commonwealth. Horses that do not reside in PA must have a CVI issued within 30 days of import. Horses that reside in PA must have a CVI issued after 5/1/18.

The CVI shall specify the collected date, resulted date and results of the EIA test, along with the accession number and the testing laboratory information.

Piroplasmosis testing requirements:

A.If an equine animal has resided in Texas or New Mexico for a cumulative total of 30 days or more within the six months prior to the date of entry, that animal must be test-negative for Piroplasmosis (*Babesia caballi* and *Theileria equi*) c-ELISA test, with the test occurring within the 30 days prior to entry. The date of test and the test results shall be written on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

B. This requirement shall *not* be applicable to an equine animal that is being transported through Pennsylvania to another State, and that is not offloaded or commingled with other equine animals while within Pennsylvania.
