I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Unless otherwise specified, Hunter Champion and Reserve Champion titles will be awarded to two of the four horses or ponies which have acquired the most points in over fences classes. In addition to these points, only those horses or ponies shall receive full points for under saddle classes and half points for model. Ties will be broken in accordance with USEF HU139.
2. Post entries and late entries will be accepted at an additional cost of \$50.00 per entry as long as space remains available. Additional classes may be added to any entry, without penalty, by 5pm the night before. Same-day adds to an entry are subject to a \$10/class penalty, as long as space remains available.
3. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary.
4. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
5. Management reserves the right to decline any entry of persons suspended or expelled from the Federation. Management reserves the right to decline any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior at Licensed Competition or towards its management, which management is able to substantiate, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a Licensed Competition which management is able to substantiate.
6. MANAGEMENT, THE COMMITTEE, AND/OR QUENTIN RIDING CLUB WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT WHICH MAY OCCUR TO ANY EXHIBITOR, OWNER, ATTENDANT, HORSE OR EQUIPMENT AT THE SHOW.
7. Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decisions shall be final.
8. All protests will be handled in accordance with USEF GR603.
9. Rotating Jump orders will be posted at all rings as needed. Exhibitors failing to appear at their designated time will be eliminated. In the event of a conflict, notify all starters involved and one ring will wait a maximum of 3 minutes for you to appear and show.
10. Management reserves the right to cancel any class if the required entries have not been received, and to combine any division if necessary, to change any obstacle or alter any course.
11. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
12. Prize money will be credited to horse's accounts. Please allow 45 minutes for processing. Any credit balance will be paid to the owner of record (unless we are notified otherwise in writing) within 30 days of the show. All refund checks must be cashed within 60 days.
13. Eight Ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise noted.
14. In jumper classes, ties involving first place must be jumped off. Ties for other than first place will be decided by time taken in the first round.
15. Management reserves the right to limit the courtesy circle with a dotted line.

16. A fee of \$75.00 will be charged for all returned checks or disputed credit cards. The horse show reserves the right to require guaranteed funds from exhibitors.
17. All dogs must be on a leash. Owners whose dogs are caught in or near any competition ring will be charged \$100.00 or the entry fee for the class in progress, whichever is greater.
18. Golf carts and/or motor bikes must be operated by a person in possession of a motor vehicle operators license. See USEF GR301.
19. USEF approved headgear must be worn when mounted while on the showgrounds.
20. Social Security or taxpayer I.D. numbers, as well as a signed, open check, will be required in the show office before any horse numbers may be picked up.
21. No stall requests will be accepted without full payment.
22. All hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness, unless otherwise noted.
23. SCHOOLING OVER FENCES in the show rings is prohibited at all times! Ample jumps in the appropriate areas will be provided for schooling. Hours for schooling on the flat will be posted.
24. **POLING: MANUAL POLING** of any horse or pony OR the use of a bamboo offset is **PROHIBITED** at all times while on the show grounds. Horses in violation will be suspended from showing for a period of 24 hours from the time of the incident.
25. All exhibitors are required to present proof of current USEF and USHJA membership, or pay the \$30 per organization non-member fees. If showing in amateur restricted classes, exhibitors must provide proof of current USEF amateur status or pay the \$30 non-member amateur fee. All horses must provide proof of USHJA Registration or pay the \$30 fee.
26. Bio Hazardous Medical Waste Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of waste or be subject to \$100 fine.

ENTRIES CLOSE April 30, 2012

Entries and stalls will be limited as necessary and will be taken on a paid, first-come, first-serve basis.

Post entries and late entries will be accepted at an additional charge of \$35.00 per entry as long as space remains available. Late new entries received the day they show will pay a late entry fee of \$50.00 Permanent or Temporary Stalls w/doors available at \$135.00 on a paid, first-come, first-serve basis. Stall fees are not refundable. Limited daily stabling may be available at \$75/night. Call for availability.

Stalls will be available Tuesday May 8th at 12 noon, and must be vacated by Sunday midnight.

There will be no scratch fee for scratches (received in writing) before the start of the St. Christopher's Horse Show. A \$35 scratch fee will be charged on or after May 9th.

Office fee is non-refundable.

No rider shall be eligible who has not ridden in at least two classes. Entry must be made on the entry blank or in the show office. Riders are eligible for only one Best Child Rider Award.

11. **TAYLOR HARRIS INSURANCE NCM/M&S CHILD MEDAL - HORSE**

Open to all Junior members of the USEF or Equine Canada who have never competed in a National Equitation Final with fences at 3'6" (i.e. Pessoa/USEF Medal; ASPCA Maclay; USEF Talent Search, CET or CEF Finals; WIHS). To be shown over a minimum of eight fences 2'9" to 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top 4 riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from tests 1-19. Course to include two changes of direction and a combination. An Open Numerical Scoring System is used in the first round.

12. ARIAT NATIONAL ADULT MEDAL/FARNUM ADULT MEDAL

Open to all Amateur members of the USEF or Equine Canada who are eligible to compete in the Adult Amateur Hunter Section at this show. A rider may not compete at the same horse show in any hunter or equitation class in which the jumps exceed three feet, three inches (3'3"). To be shown over a minimum of eight fences not to exceed 3' in height, spread not to exceed fence height. The course may be either a Jumper or Hunter type course and must include at least two changes of direction and a combination. Water obstacles (i.e.; water jump, liverpool) are not permitted. The top 4 riders are required to perform at least two individual tests from tests 1-19. Course to include two changes of direction and a combination. An Open Numerical Scoring System is used in the first round.

13. LEAD LINE WALK - sponsored by *CHERYL VULICH, JACK GAUGHEN REALTOR*

Entry Fee \$10.00 - exempt from post entry fee if received at least one hour before start of class

Open to children who have not reached their 7th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year, not showing in any other classes except the Hunter Seat Walk Trot Section. To be judged on manners and suitability of pony to rider - 50%, and horsemanship of rider - 50%. To be led by an adult.

14. LEAD LINE WALK-TROT - sponsored by *CHERYL VULICH, JACK GAUGHEN REALTOR*

Entry Fee \$10.00- exempt from post entry fee if received at least one hour before start of class

Open to children who have not reached their 7th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year, not showing in any other classes except the Hunter Seat Walk Trot Section. To be judged on manners and suitability of pony to rider - 50%, and horsemanship of rider - 50%. To be led by an adult.

15. LOW/PRE-ADULT EQUITATION

Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to Adult Amateur riders showing in the Low/Pre-Adult Hunters. Fences 2'6".

PRE-CHILD EQUITATION

Entry Fee \$25.00

Open to Junior riders showing in the Low/Pre-Children's Hunters. Tests 1-7. Fences 2' for ponies; 2'6" for horses.

- 16. LOW/PRE-CHILD EQUITATION - PONY**
- 17. LOW/PRE-CHILD EQUITATION - HORSE**

18. JOSEY MOHLER EQUITATION

Open to junior riders on horses only. To jump eight or more fences. The course must contain at least one oxer, a combination and at least one change of direction after the first fence. Fence height 3'. The judge will then select at least one-fourth of the class, but not less than six (6) riders if available, to show at a walk, trot and canter. The same horse must be used in all phases. Class to be judged on hands, seat, legs, guidance and control of mount throughout. Jumping faults not to count unless the fault of the rider. The under-saddle portion of the class to count 50%. USEF tests 1-18 may be used. Rider may not show in the H & H Tack Shop Equitation class at the same show.

H & H TACK SHOP EQUITATION - PONIES ONLY

Open to any junior rider not showing in any class where fences exceed 3'3" in the first round. To jump eight or more fences. The course must contain an oxer and at least one change of direction after the first fence. Fence heights to be 2' for small and medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
